On average, someone in the UK is diagnosed with cancer at least **every 90 seconds**.

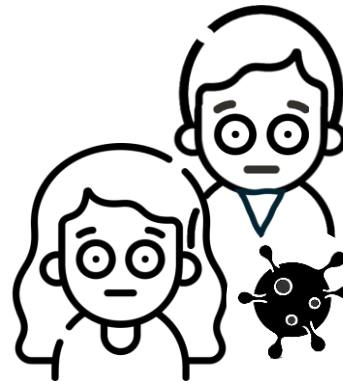
Every year some **181,807** people die from cancer.
